## Requirements for projects funded by the GFA Version of September 9<sup>th</sup> 2022

## The GFA

## **Requirements and recommendations**

To accompany your project and publish content on our website and social media, we would like to ask you for the following:

Before the event/launch of the project:

- One-Pager of the project as soon as possible with at least these data:
  - Title
    - Outline of the project
    - Draft Program
    - Partners (Industry/Academia)
    - Link to the website as soon as it exists
    - Hashtag for social media
- Press release approximately 1 month before the launch or start of the event to advertise the project in our network and online
- Please tag us in your social media posts: Twitter @AFA\_DFA, <u>https://www.linkedin.com/company/germanfrenchacademy</u>
- Point out the financing by IMT and the GFA on communications of the project and its results.

During the event:

- o Short article with highlights from every event day

  - Short CV for every speaker on the videos
