This template covers the basic sections and question of an after-event-survey for participants, organizers and speakers. Feel free to use and change it to be suitable for your event, and integrate it in an online form.

# 1. Section – background of the person

- How old are you?

  of the future editions?

- Which topics would you propose for future editions?
  - Text answer
- How can we make the Future-IoT series better known?
  - o Text answer
- What would be our preferred months for the next edition?
  - Text answer
